This year wasn't easy- not in the slightest. But guess what? We made it look easy.

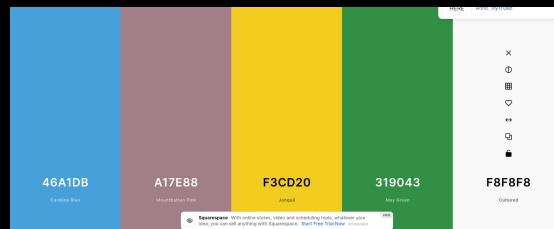
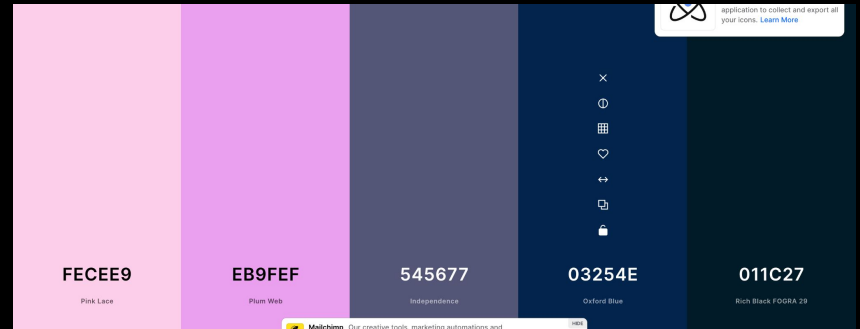
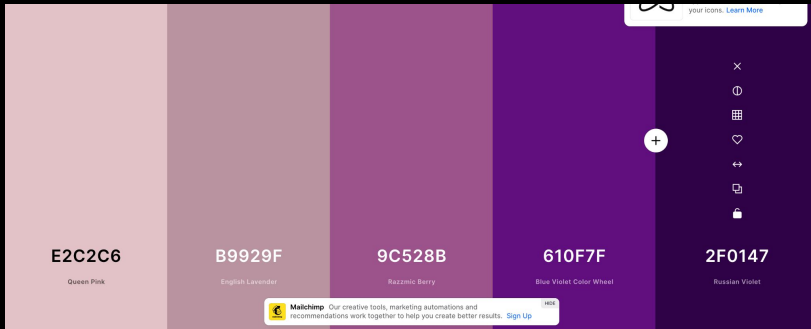
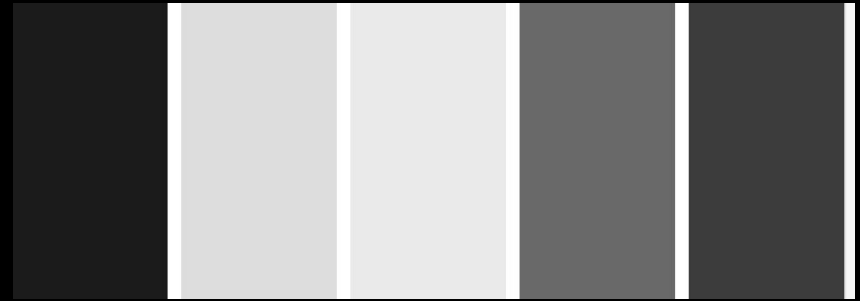
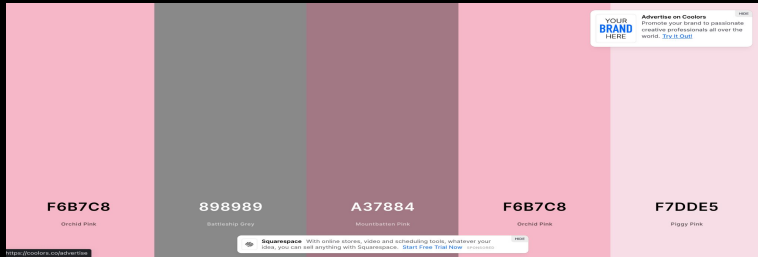
